Flex Styles and Skins

The default Flex theme is called 'Halo'

Works fine for development but can get old to look at

Flex gives us several options to work with to change the look and feel of our Flex Applications

- Styles
- Skins
- Themes

Programmatic Skinning

You can use either

`flash.display.Graphics()` class

or

Degrafa

To programmatically skin your app
